

Sankei have obtained GRS

The Global Recycle Standard (GRS) is recycled products standard that sets requirements for third-party certifications. GRS certifies eco-friendly production based on environmental consideration and social responsibility by observing the use of recycled materials in products.

GRS was originally developed by Control Union Certifications (CUC) in 2008 and ownership was passed to Textile Exchange January 1, 2011. Control Union Japan is accredited as an official certification organization in Japan. With an increased interest in a sustainability especially in western countries, Inditex Group (ZARA etc.), H&M, and other companies have decided to require GRS certification of their suppliers within 5 to 10 years. Market needs for a replacement of materials into recycled or sustainable resources for all products brings GRS' s international attention.
