

INTRODUCTION TO SANKEI TOCHIGI QUILTING FACTORY – LAMINATING PROCESS

Do you have any need for inner cotton combined with non-woven fabric?

We can help reduce processing fees, by saving time and effort in the sewing factory and therefore create more margin.



What is Laminating?

It is a process to attach 2 or more layers of fabrics together and our Tochigi factory can attach non-woven fabric to inner cotton directly. This is processed in-house on roll form and adhesive is applied to inner cotton, so that non-woven fabric can be temporarily attached to it. The adhesive can be applied to one side or both sides of the inner cotton, so that the non-woven fabric can be attached on one or two sides.

※ When sewing the finished laminated fabric, please ensure that all layers are sewn, as this is only a temporary adhesive.

(The adhesive is only there to keep the fabrics together and to make it easier to sew the fabric, which is different to “THINDOWN” , which does not peel off, even after sewing).

※ The lead time depends on the season and can be confirmed at point of enquiry, along with prices.

Advantage 1

Save time in the sewing factory.

With us supply the combined material this way, it avoids you having to cut each piece one by one and then layering the material before sewing, which makes it much easier and quicker to handle, especially if you are applying spray adhesive to each piece.

Advantage 2

Avoids wrinkles during transportation and sewing.

In the case of a soft textured inner cotton, it is easier to transport and cut the combined fabric, which reduces the risk of wrinkles on one or both sides.
